FAQ'S

We'd like to answer a few questions you might have as you decide to be our guest this Sunday.

1. *What time are your services?* Our Sunday Gathering begins each Sunday at 10:00 AM
2. *How do I get there?* Sunday gatherings are at held every Sunday at: Roosevelt Middle School, 3366 Park Blvd, San Diego, CA 92103
3. *How long are the services?* Our services last about 75 minutes and contain music and teaching from the Bible that will apply directly to your life.
4. *Is there a dress code?* No. Feel free to dress in clothes that are comfortable for you when you come to New City. You can "dress up" if you want, or wear casual clothes. God is interested in your heart, not your wardrobe.
5. *Will I be singled out if I'm new?* Absolutely not. You are our guest. Each Sunday, there are lots of people just like you who are checking out Calvary for the first time. 6. *What about my kids?* New City has an exciting Children's ministry called "City Kids" where your kids will be taught the Bible in age-appropriate classes.
